**REQUIREMENTS:** You must apply in person.

You must bring the following items:

- Your driver's license, state photo I.D. or other government issued photo ID to prove you are at least 18 years old.
- Your original High School Diploma or G.E.D. equivalent
- \$125.00 non-refundable application fee (\$140 with test taking tip book)

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. Must be able to read, write, and speak English.
2. Must have a High School Diploma or G.E.D. equivalent.
3. Pass an aptitude test
4. Pass a drug screen
5. Pass a physical
6. Pass an agility test
7. Applicants must possess a valid driver's license

**THERE ARE ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS TO THESE REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS**

Applicants submitting the required documents will be given all the information where and when to appear for the aptitude test (Offered in May) (See \*above to purchase Test-taking tips book), drug screen (if applicable), physical (if applicable), and physical agility test (if applicable). The applicants that pass the minimum requirements of the aptitude test, drug screening, physical and physical agility test will be notified by email and invited to the oral interviews (August 2020).

At the time of indenture you must:

- Have a valid Driver's license
- Have a reliable form of transportation
- Pass a drug test
